

Wild West Fringe walking



Some of the best accessible wild routes across Torridon, Strathcarron, Glen Elg and Knoydart with unsurpassed West Coast scenery in uncompromising terrain. Every day takes one into surroundings which are diversely stunning and full of wildlife.

This six night trip reaches a climax as we cross Loch Hourne to savour the Rough Bounds of Knoydart with the last night at Inverie. Very lightweight backpacking is required for this last day's walk. On the last morning our trip is rounded off with a sail out to Mallaig before returning to Stirling.

Ferry Journeys

There is always a slight possibility on trips involving ferries, that severe weather conditions or other reasons will prevent a scheduled sailing. However unlikely this may be on this trip, it may not be possible to keep to the planned timings.
